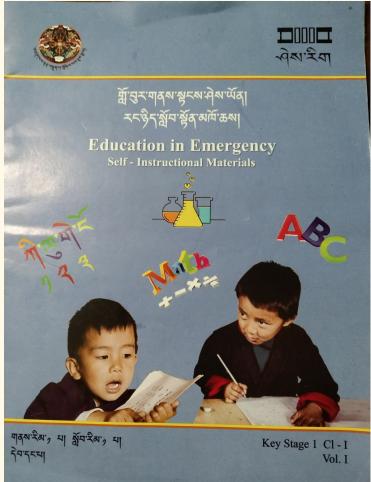

RATIONALE



The detection of first COVID-19 case on 5th March, 2020 resulted in closure of schools and institutes in the proximal zone of Paro, Thimphu and Punakha. Subsequently, in compliance to the executive order of the government, all schools and educational institutes in the country were closed from March 18, 2020 until the further notice.

School closure due to COVID-19 brought irreparable disruption to the education sector in the world. Globally over 1.5 billion youths could no longer physically go to schools. Students staying home became the new normal forcing students, government and relevant agencies to turn to alternative sources to continue their education. The prolonged closure of the schools affected the education in achieving the learning outcomes for all key stages. Inevitably, such hindrance effects the progression of students to

the next higher grade resulting in the creation of generation gap in the career opportunities.

Understanding the priority to facilitate the continuity of learning and to ensure the learners engagement in the meaningful learning, the ministry of education in collaboration with REC, BCSEA and other relevant stakeholders have initiated a number of programmes and activities to roll out education in emergency (EiE). An eLearning programme, a national move where teachers are called to television studios to broadcast lesson that was aired on daily basis on Television or Radios at the scheduled time for all grades was one national initiative to connect all the remote communities which are not accessible.

The curriculum was also adopted and prioritized to deliver desired learning outcomes. In addition to the e-Learning programme, a variety of online media such as Google Classroom orientation to teachers was a mandate. Nevertheless, creation of We Chat, Messenger, Telegram, and WhatsApp groups whichever student finds reliable are brought into practice for the meaningful engagement of the students. For some students, access to online education was a challenge or not possible due to parents unaffordability to own a smart phone, poor network coverage, expensive data and geographical landscape. In response to this, the ministry of education released Self Instructional Materials (SIM), an alternative print resource for children deprived to e-learning platform.

The national theme for this initiative was 'Reaching the Unreached' which was aimed to benefit those unfortunate children. To meet the national theme 'Reaching the Unreached', series of school level meetings (virtual meeting) were convened headed by Principal, Academic head and secretary, where a core group was created which was responsible for receiving, recording and distributing the SIM through various means such as handing SIM materials to Chiwog Tshogpas and reaching to distribute SIM materials personally. Another strategy school adopted to assess student's work in far flung communities was alternative teaching by mobile teachers.

The teachers teaching classes PP-VIII were grouped and are responsible for assessing students work, teach and guide students to complete their activities, collecting students write up and getting it corrected by concern subject teacher and give it back to students. This gave students the confidence and opportunity to continue their education bringing them into the mainstream.

For students who are already into campus (X students, later joined by IX students), their learning continued even during the national lockdown. Since school caters the boarding facilities, school was also declared self-containment zone and nobody was allowed to come in or go out of campus. Video lesson on different subjects as per the schedule was screened to engage students. To consider psycho social wellbeing of students in the campus, counselling programme and games and sports schedule was prepared and undertaken without fail. Giving the priority to health protocol, social distancing, hand washing/sanitizing and mask wearing were never missed in any of the school events instead daily thermal scanning, classroom, hostel and dining room sanitizing and washing were included apart from health guideline.

Mirror Reflection on Alternative Teaching (2020)

Archibald MacLeish states 'There is only one thing more painful than learning experience and that is not leaning from experience.' In order to provide and facilitate the learning experience to the children, the mobile teachers grouped by the school administration visited various locations of Kamji CS catchment areas within green zone.



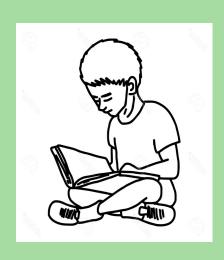
TashiLakha PS road point

After witnessing the overwhelming number of students gathered at the point, the team firstly briefed the



group on health safety and covid-19 protocol. Then they devoted on teaching learning process followed by scaffolding in respective subjects. Consequently, note books were collected to further handover to subject teachers concerned. One of the students of Tashilakha (Agaon) was met personally by the team to provide guidance and assess his learning as he could not come to the identified station owing to the distance. Finally, having spent adequate time, the team bid farewell to the students with a cheerful smile and encouraged to continue their online learning, despite unending challenges.





Alternative teaching Report 2nd round





The successful and insightful experience from the first round of alternative teaching motivated teachers to revisit for the review of the students' work and hand over the assessed books.

To further ensure the efficacy and to understand the ground reality, the team was accompanied by the academic head to all the locations.

Academic Head oriented on health safety, COVID-19 protocol and safe drinking water. Also focused on significance and consistency of eLearning.

Despite the long hours of academic discussions, the need of the students were addressed explicitly.

Hence, the journey of alternative teaching was adventurous, experiential and fruitful covering all the facet of education in emergency. The hope and aspirations of both learners and teachers were achieved inline with school plans. However, the school regrets for not covering the students residing in the red zone owing to COVID-19 protocols.

The teaching-learning experience at Druk Mining and Suntolakha

School decided to have field visit teachings in order to narrow the gap and connect all students individually. So, according to the plan we were assigned to visit Mining and Sungtolakha areas to meet eleven non-respondent students at Sungtalakha and six at mining. However to our astonishment, there were fifty two students who turned out including online learners. Our team focused on clearing the doubts, completion of the task and collection of books to be distributed to the subject teachers for correction, verification and assessment. Beside academic activities we also emphasized on health safety and covid -19 protocol. Later, all the books were corrected, verified, assessed and returned.

On 20.10 and 12.11.2020 team members (Teachers: Sangay Bidha, Jamyang Lhamo, Yeshi Dema and Dechen Lhamo) departed for their designated areas.

Special Educational Needs (SEN) 2020 Phase-I

To support the students with learning difficulties in times of Covid-19, the SEN Team led by the SEN-Co discussed and tried to explore different strategies to support the students with special needs. SEN team looked for the possibilities to contact with the parents to enquire about the ICT facilities to create an emergency learning group (Wechat/messenger). However, it resulted that most of the parent's phones are in switched-off mode and some are not responding.

Therefore, the SEN team came to the conclusion as a resolution to divide the students among the teachers to contact with the students to support during the Covid-19 crisis.

Teachers are responsible to keep in touch with the students daily and frame relevant activities to engage the students during the break.

Special Educational Needs (SEN)2020 Phase-II

Upon receiving Prioritized curriculum from the Ministry of Education, the lesson for SEN students are delivered online using the Prioritized curriculum focussing on basic literacy and numeracy skills in (Dzongkha, English & Mathematics). However, after lifting the nations lockdown, students of classes IX-XII have resumed their studies on campus. Since Miss. Dawa Zam (SEN) student from class IX was also back to her regular studies in the school, three SEN teachers are currently catering SEN services on basic literacy and numeracy skills through contact teaching.



EiE Result Analysis - 2020

The Academic result declaration,2020 from classes PP to VIII is mainly based on the EiE curriculum framework provided by the ministry of education. The year long learning of the students through online media, Radio and Television lesson was assessed for the promotion of the students. The learning of the students in this new normal was assessed through the quality, relevancy, accuracy and completion of work assigned by the subject teachers.

The assessment is based on three competency level Approaching, Meeting and Exceeding. The graphical image below demonstrates the analysis of students achievement in academic based on the competency level.
